IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Health Form Requirements:

Each camper must have had a health examination within twenty-four (24) months of the camp session and present a health form signed by a licensed physician as well as a recent health history completed by a parent. For new campers – necessary health forms will be included in your confirmation packet. For returning campers - if your medical forms on file are no longer current/valid all necessary forms will be included in your confirmation packet.

Liability Release Forms:

All campers are also required to have a current Liability Release Form on file in the ranch office during their stay. The form will be included with your confirmation packet if a valid form is not already on file.

All completed medical/liability forms must arrive at the ranch office no later than two weeks prior to your camp date.

Arrival/Departure Information: Due to the Christmas holiday falling on Sunday we have adjusted our camp opening to give families & staff as much time with their families & travel to camp as possible. Campers will check-in on Tuesday, **Dec. 27 between 2:00-4:00 p.m.** The closing show on Monday, Jan. 2 will begin at 9:45 a.m. (Gates will open at 9:00 a.m.).

Important—Before registering be sure read our cancellation policy. If you have any questions please ask **BEFORE completing your registration.**

Cancellation/Refund Policy: Please consider/review the cancellation policy before making your camp reservation. In order to provide the highest quality camp program & staffing we must plan well in advance based on confirmed reservations. For that reason, after the final payment deadline of Nov. 15, 2011 no refunds will be issued by Rawhide Ranch for cancellations.

IMPORTANT CANCELLATION INSURANCE INFORMATION: Many, many families take advantage of camp insurance to help with unexpected emergencies or changes in plans that might come up. Read the next paragraph regarding the purchase of camp cancellation insurance to cover all sorts of last minute emergency situations, illness, change in camper readiness, etc. + “for any reason” cancellation insurance.

Many parents have inquired about camp cancellation protection to cover their investment in Camp for their children. This is particularly important as the holidays are approaching and plans can change unexpectedly. We make available a competitively priced program that we believe meets the needs of our families. We highly recommend you review this plan created especially for the Camp industry. Complete details and enrollment forms for this optional plan are available online at www.travmark.com or with your camper's confirmation packet which will be arriving in the mail shortly. Life sometimes unexpectedly interrupts camp plans. If you are concerned about last minute change in plans, illness or injury, camper readiness, etc. that might prevent attending camp you will want to check out camp cancellation insurance to help cover your financial investment in this important part of your child's life.

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Age Requirements:

Campers must be between the ages of 7 & 15 during their camp session.

When Choosing This Camp Session:

Please plan to give your camper the opportunity to fully participate in the camp experience rather than having to leave camp for appointments, sports, vacation, etc. It is very disruptive to the camp program. Please make this camp experience a priority for your child during their stay. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Bunking Request Guidelines:

Campers are pre-assigned a cabin for the camp session. Cabin dynamics are an important part of the camp experience. Therefore each camper may request a max. of 2 bunkmates. To help with the bunking assignments **buddies should request each other** (see below). As a general rule we recommend that parents do not request siblings to be bunked together. Campers are bunked by age so bunkmates need to be close in age (within one year). As last minute bunking changes are very difficult to arrange, all requests must be made at least one week prior to the start of camp session. Our program is designed for campers to have the opportunity to spend the majority of their day within their program group rather than their cabin group so a larger group of friends or friends of varied ages may choose to be in the same program group and enjoy lots of time together.

Important Note Regarding Negative Bunking Issues: We cannot accommodate negative bunkmate requests unless a signed request is in writing and on file in the camp office. If a camper (negative requested) requests to be placed in your child's cabin (very common), we will need to inform the parents of the circumstances behind our inability to accommodate their request. We encourage you to work out these issues among the families prior to arrival at camp.
