IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Health Form Requirements: Each camper must have had a health examination within twenty-four (24) months of the camp session and present a health form signed by a licensed physician as well as a recent health history completed by a parent. For new campers – necessary health forms will be included in your confirmation packet. For returning campers - if your medical forms on file are no longer current/valid all necessary forms will be included in your confirmation packet.

Liability Release Forms: All campers are also required to have a current Liability Release Form on file in the ranch office during their stay. The form will be included with your confirmation packet if a valid form is not already on file.

All completed medical/liability forms must arrive at the ranch office no later than two weeks prior to your camp date.

Cancellation Policy: The camp fee includes a \$200 per session non-refundable/non-transferable deposit. Should the need to cancel a reservation occur, the deposit may not be applied to a future program nor to another camper. For any cancellation received prior to final payment deadline, the camp fee will be refunded minus the non-refundable deposit (\$200 per session). **In order to provide the highest quality program we must plan well in advance based on confirmed reservations. For that reason, after the final payment date of June 1 for those reservations received prior OR for new registrations received after June 1, 2010 for your child's camp session no refunds will be issued for cancellations.** Please do not ask us to make an exception for you. Read the next paragraph regarding the purchase of camp cancellation insurance to cover all sorts of last minute emergency situations + "for any reason" cancellation insurance.

To summarize cancellation policy once a space becomes available:

If you register your camper using the "Deposit Only Option" (if available) your payment of \$200 is non-refundable at any time.

If you register your camper using the "Payment In Full Option" and your cancellation is received in writing prior to June 1 you will be eligible for a refund of any additional payment over and above the \$200 deposit portion of your payment which is non-refundable.

If you register your camper after June 1 your full camp tuition payment of \$865 is non-refundable by Rawhide Ranch.

What can we do in the event of a change in plans or change in camper readiness? Consider **camp cancellation protection** to your investment in Summer Camp. We make available a competitively priced program that we believe meets the needs of our families. We highly recommend you review this plan created especially for the Camp industry. Complete details and enrollment forms for this optional plan are available online at www.travmark.com. If you are concerned about last minute change in plans, illness, camper readiness, etc. that might prevent attending camp as planned, this is something you will want to check out to help cover your financial investment.

Final payments for summer camp sessions will be due on/before June 1st. New registrations will continue to be accepted after payment due dates as long as space remains available.

Photography: I understand that Rawhide Ranch may make, procure, or use photographs, films, tapes, or other likenesses of camper's physical image/voice as may be needed for use with publicity materials. Full names of campers are not used in any promotional materials.

To Bring or Not To Bring: It is important for parents to know that we do not allow the following items to be brought to camp. Any of the following items that make their way to camp with your camper will be held safely in the camp office until check-out on the closing day of camp.

Cell phones, IPOD/MP3 players, TVs, Video games, GameBoys, personal sports equipment, cell phones, pagers, PDA's, etc.
Pocket knives, sling-shots, weapons etc. Also please leave all pets/animals at home (even during check-in/check-out).

We thank you in advance for helping us to insure the safety of our campers & staff by respecting our policies for attending camp at Rawhide Ranch.

MORE IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Age Requirements: Campers must be between the ages of 7 & 15 during their camp session.

When Choosing a Date: Please plan to give your camper the opportunity to fully participate in the camp experience rather than having to leave camp for school or doctor appointments, sports, vacation, etc. It is very disruptive to the camp program. **If there is going to be a schedule conflict during your camper's stay please make camp a priority and select another session.**

Bunking Request Guidelines: Campers are pre-assigned a cabin for the camp session. Cabin dynamics are an important part of the summer camp experience. Therefore each camper may request a max. of 2 bunkmates. To help with the bunking assignments buddies should request each other. As a general rule we recommend that parents do not request siblings to be bunked together. Campers are bunked by age so bunkmates need to be close in age (within one year). As last minute bunking changes are very difficult to arrange, all requests must be made at least one week prior to the start of camp session. Our program is designed for campers to have the opportunity to spend the majority of their day within their program group rather than their cabin group so a larger group of friends or friends of varied ages may choose to be in the same program group and enjoy lots of time together.

IMPORTANT: All negative bunkmate requests (i.e. "I don't want my child to be with.....") must be requested in writing and on file in the camp office. If a camper (the negative requested) requests to be placed in your child's cabin (very common), we will need to inform the child's parents of the circumstances behind our inability to accommodate their request.
