



Greetings from Rawhide Ranch:

Rawhide Ranch has been serving area schools since 1963. We are located near Bonsall (northern San Diego County) and offer a high quality learning experience for school groups. This unique overnight experience offers students the chance to experience life science at a real working quarter horse ranch in an Old-West town setting. Additionally, this out-of-the-classroom opportunity fosters adolescent independence, teamwork and a new excitement for learning while meeting many of the California State Education Content Standards for grades 2-8.

If you are considering a change in your current school trips or are looking to add a new experience for your students we hope you will read on.....

The daily schedule includes classes focusing on animal and horse science as well as western-style horseback riding and vaulting (gymnastics on horseback). Students get to experience the inner workings of the ranch during daily animal care time in our stock farm & livery stables. The evening activities include group games/activities for all campers. During the final day of your program parents are invited to spend the morning visiting the ranch and see their camper in action.

Students and chaperones are assigned to a variety of rustic housing areas (typically in the Fort Rawhide, the Olde Schoolhouse bunkhouses &/or Tee Pee Village). Meals are included in the fee, with our professional chef preparing home-cooked meals. Guest lunches are also available on the final day (extra charge).

The current program cost is **\$205/participant for 2017** and **\$217/participant for 2018** for a **3-day program** which runs **Wed through Fri**. The riding and vaulting classes are exclusively for the students. Because of this we offer a discounted rate for the adults. 2 faculty/adults come at half price, plus for every 10 students you will receive 1 additional adult at ½ price as well. Minimum group size is 25 students with a maximum group size of 100 people (students + chaperones). If group size is less than the maximum we reserve the right to book another school/group during the same session. Each school will also be asked to provide a current certificate of insurance with Rawhide Ranch as an additional insured.

The reservation requires a 10% non-refundable deposit within one month of scheduling with the final count and final payment due one month prior to your visit.

Rawhide Ranch is proud to be nationally accredited by the Certified Horsemanship Association (CHA) assuring our participants that we meet the highest of safety standards for equestrian facilities.
