- ★ **Daily Check-In** - Each morning at 8:15am you will check your child in.
- ★ **Daily Check-Out** - Each afternoon at 4:00pm you will need to sign them out (we will check **photo ID** so please have it handy to show us). Anyone picking your child up must be listed as a contact person in your account or on the Authorized Camper Pick-Up form (in your online account).
- ★ **Lunch will be provided each day.**
- ★ Early drop off & breakfast starting at 7:30am available for \$8 per day. **Please purchase this option ahead of time.**
- ★ A Late Pick-Up fee will be added starting at **4:15pm** at a rate of \$3 every 15 minutes. To purchase this ahead of time please contact the Ranch office.

IMPORTANT: Each day campers must show up in long pants, T-shirts (no tank tops) and close toed shoes (boots or sturdy sneakers; NO slip-on type sneakers, must have good protection).

We will have the pool open all week as well as some other activities for which they will need a change of clothes. Below is a list of what they will need to bring each day. We will have cabins open and available for the campers to get changed in (boys & girls separate).

Pack a bag/backpack with:

- ★ Bathing Suit & Towel...(Girls - either a one-piece bathing suit or a two-piece with a colored t-shirt to wear over it is acceptable)
 - ★ Shorts & Sneakers
 - ★ Refillable Water Bottle
 - ★ Sun Screen
 - ★ Hat
 - ★ Mask/Face Covering

\$5 - \$10 per day in Pony Bucks account (through Fun Fangle) for spending money for Snack Shop & Country Store (please set up your account ahead of time. An email will be sent to you to do this).

Medications: Lunch time medications must be checked in at the office upon arrival. Medications should be in original container with the child's name and dosage instructions on them.

What to Leave at Home:

All electronic games/equipment, e- books/readers, **Cell phones**/Ipods/MP3/IPad's, etc. Pocket knives, personal sports equipment.

For safety reasons, pocket knives, illegal substances and hazardous materials (e.g. matches, fireworks, weapons, etc.) are prohibited. Any prohibited item (or other inappropriate/hazardous item) brought to camp will be held at the office until the end of day. Any cell phone or other electronics brought to camp will be safely stored in the office until the end of the day.
