General Packing List

You will be carrying your luggage from the parking lot to the cabin, so **PACK LIGHTLY!!** (wagons are a great idea)

(Each cabin has bunk beds w/ foam pads. Helpful Hint – Bring twin size fitted sheets for the beds)

Favorite stuffed animal for the kids

Camera

Sunscreen

Flashlight

Refillable water bottle

First Aid Kit (Each family is responsible for their own first aid care. See Health & Safety Policies)

For Group Lessons...

Riding

Cowboy or Hiking Type Boots
(Sturdy Sneakers are ok; no slip-on's)
Jeans
T-Shirts (no Tank Tops)
Required for Riding

Vaulting

Shorts or Stretchy Pants (yoga, sweatpants, etc)
Tennis Shoes
Required for Vaulting

What NOT To Bring...

- Weapons of Any Kind
- Alcohol / Illegal Substances
- Personal Sports Equipment
- Expensive cameras & video equipment
- Electric Heaters / Blankets
- All Electronics – Laptops, Games, Tablet, etc (**Sorry, no Wi-Fi**)
- Valuable Items (Cabins do not lock from the outside)
- Please Leave Pets at Home!

***The cabins are NOT Heated or Cooled so pack accordingly!**

Due to fire marshal & insurance regulations, portable heaters, electric blankets, etc are not allowed in sleeping areas.

Rawhide Ranch is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items.

Please keep in mind we are a ranch with many animals and there's always a chance of items getting dirty, broken or lost.

Each family is responsible for their own first aid care (see Health & Safety Policies).

Food & beverages are not allowed in the cabin areas.

~Families will **check-in** at **6:00 pm** on **Friday** in the Hotel (office). There is **no dinner on Friday night** so please eat before you get here. Orientation will begin promptly after check-in, so please do not be late!

~Upon arrival, park in the Ranch's main parking lot and walk up Main Street to the Stockman Hotel for check-in. Here we will give you a schedule, tell you where your cabin is and let you know what the first activity will be. **Please keep in mind that you will be carrying all of your luggage from the parking lot to your cabin, so pack lightly!**

~All of the **required forms** must be completed and submitted for each person attending. The forms must be completed at the time of registration through the families online account. If a child is coming with your family whose parent/guardian will not be in attendance, their parent must agree to and sign all of the required forms.

~ In addition to the general activities, there will be group riding and vaulting lessons (beginner) available for sign up throughout the weekend. Minimum age requirement of 7 years old applies for riding. We will have a lead line class available for those under 7 on Sunday. This is due to insurance regulations, please make sure anyone under 7 knows this ahead of time. We will have activities for them while their family members are in riding class.

~Departure will be on **Sunday** after our lunch time Ranch BBQ.

All of us here at Rawhide Ranch are very excited to experience this amazing adventure with you, your family and friends! We will have so many exciting opportunities going on during the weekend, so prepare for a weekend full of fun and relaxation. How to get to Rawhide Ranch:

**6987 West Lilac Road
Bonsall, CA 92003**

From Los Angeles/Orange County:

Drive INTERSTATE 5 South to Oceanside. HWY 76 off-ramp is just past Oceanside Harbor; head EAST on HWY 76. In Bonsall, turn RIGHT on CAMINO DEL REY, cross the bridge, stay LEFT at the Y in the road and just at the corner of the golf course turn LEFT on WEST LILAC ROAD. Rawhide Ranch is up the hill (approx. 3 miles); you'll see the sign on the RIGHT.

From San Diego:

Drive INTERSTATE 15 NORTH to OLD HWY 395/US-395, turn LEFT at end of ramp. Go to top of hill; turn LEFT onto WEST LILAC ROAD. Ranch is approx. 1.6 miles ahead on your left.

From Riverside/San Bernardino:

Drive INTERSTATE 15 SOUTH past Temecula. Take HWY 76 exit WEST towards PALA/OCEANSIDE. Turn LEFT onto OLD HWY 395 (at gas station plaza). Go up to top of hill. Turn RIGHT onto WEST LILAC ROAD. Ranch is approx. 1.6 miles ahead on your left.
