General Packing List

You will be carrying your luggage from the parking lot to the cabin, so **PACK LIGHTLY!!** (wagons are a great idea)

- ★ Jeans
- ★ T-shirts (with a sleeve; short or long ok)
- **★** Pajamas
- ★ Socks (for shoes and/or boots; bring extra socks for riding)
- ★ Underwear
- ★ Warm Jacket/Sweatshirt mornings and nights are chilly!
- * Rain Gear/Mud Boots Just In Case
- ★ Shower Shoes/Flip Flops
- ★ Hat (Cowboy or baseball style)
- ★ Bandana(s)
- ★ Toiletries (Soap, shampoo, comb/brush, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- ★ Bath Towel, wash cloth (Rawhide Ranch does not provide towels!)
- ★ Ear Plugs (in case you're bunking with a noisy sleeper zzz)
- ★ <u>Warm Sleeping Bag/Pillow</u>/*<u>Extra Blanket</u> (Cabins have bunk beds w/ foam pads)
 - o Helpful Hint Bring a twin size fitted sheet to put over the foam pad & lay your sleeping bag on top.
- **★** Camera
- ★ Sunscreen
- **★** Flashlight
- ★ Refillable water bottle
- ★ Personal hand sanitizer
- ★ First Aid Kit (Each family is responsible for their own first aid care. See Health & Safety Policies)
- ★ Spending Money (Sweet Shop & Country Store will be open! **No bills larger than \$20 please.**
 - Sweet Shop accepts CASH ONLY. Country Store accepts cash or credit/debit card.

What <u>NOT</u> To Bring...

- Weapons of Any Kind
- Alcohol / Illegal Substances
- Personal Sports Equipment
- Expensive cameras & video equipment
- Electric Heaters / Blankets
- All Electronics Laptops, Games, Tablet, etc (Sorry, no Wi-Fi)
- Valuable Items (Cabins do not lock from the outside)
- Please Leave Pets at Home!

*The cabins are NOT Heated or Cooled so please pack accordingly!

Due to fire marshal & insurance regulations, portable heaters, electric blankets, etc, are not allowed in sleeping areas.

Rawhide Ranch is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items. Please be mindful that we are a ranch with many animals and there's always a chance of items getting dirty, broken, or lost.

Each family is responsible for their own first aid care (see Health & Safety Policies).

Food & beverages are not allowed in the cabins or cabin areas (water is OK).

Required For Group Lessons...

Riding:

- ★ Cowboy or Hiking Type Boots (Sturdy Sneakers are ok; no slip-on's)
- ★ Jeans (long pants, must go down to the ankle)
- ★ T-Shirts (must have a sleeve, no Tank Tops)

Vaulting:

- ★ Shorts or Stretchy Pants (yoga pants, leggings, sweatpants, etc)
- ★ Tennis Shoes/Sneakers



- ♥ Check-in is at 6:00 PM on Friday. There is <u>no dinner on Friday night</u> so please <u>eat before you get here!</u> Orientation will begin promptly after check-in, so <u>please do not be late!</u>
- ♥ Upon arrival, park in the Ranch's main parking lot and walk up
 Main Street to the <u>Stockman's Hotel</u> for check-in. Here we will give you
 a schedule, tell you where your cabin is and let you know what the first
 activity will be. Please keep in mind that <u>you will be carrying all of</u>
 your luggage from the parking lot to your cabin, so pack lightly!
 Wagons are a GREAT idea to help with luggage.
- ♥ Mother/Daughter Weekend attendees may be housed together in a shared cabin. You can request to be housed with friends when you register online. Rawhide Ranch will assign each family to a cabin. Please be aware that you may be sharing a cabin with another family (all females).
- ♥ All of the **required forms** must be completed and submitted for each person attending. The forms must be completed at the time of registration through the family's online account. If a child is coming with your family whose parent/guardian will not be in attendance, their parent must register them separately so they can agree to and sign all of the required forms.
- ♥ There will be group riding and vaulting lessons (beginner) throughout the weekend, in addition to a host of other fun activities.

 Minimum age requirement of 7 years old applies for riding. We will have a lead line riding class available for those ages 3 to 6. This is due to insurance regulations and not flexible at all, so please make sure anyone under 7 knows this ahead of time. We cannot make exceptions. Anyone not yet 7 must do a lead line riding class. Children ages 0-2 do not participate.
- Departure will be on Sunday after lunch, around 1:30 PM.

All of us here at Rawhide Ranch are very excited to experience this amazing adventure with you, your family and friends! We will have so many exciting opportunities going on during the weekend, so prepare for a weekend full of fun and relaxation. It will be a wonderful chance to re-connect with nature and get to know your loved ones on a whole new level. Thank you for your support and we look forward to seeing y'all soon!

How to get to Rawhide Ranch:

6987 West Lilac Road Bonsall, CA 92003

From Los Angeles/Orange County:
Drive INTERSTATE 5 South to Oceanside.
HWY 76 off-ramp is just past Oceanside
Harbor; head EAST on HWY 76.
In Bonsall, turn RIGHT on CAMINO DEL
REY, cross the bridge, stay LEFT at the Y in
the road and just at the corner of the golf
course turn LEFT on WEST LILAC ROAD.
Rawhide Ranch is up the hill (approx. 3
miles); you'll see the sign on the RIGHT.

From San Diego:

Drive INTERSTATE 15 NORTH to OLD HWY 395/US-395, turn LEFT at end of ramp. Go to top of hill; turn LEFT onto WEST LILAC ROAD. Ranch is approx. 1.6 miles ahead on your left.

From Riverside/San Bernardino:

Drive INTERSTATE 15 SOUTH past Temecula. Take HWY 76 exit WEST towards PALA/OCEANSIDE. Turn LEFT onto OLD HWY 395 (at gas station plaza). Go up to top of hill. Turn RIGHT onto WEST LILAC ROAD. Ranch is approx. 1.6 miles ahead on your left.
