## What To Bring...

**Pack lightly!** You will be carrying your gear from the parking lot to the cabins.

- Jeans (Required for riding! Must cover ankle)
- Comfy shorts and/or pants (No short-shorts; should cover modest areas)
- T-shirts (No tank tops, no offensive logos)
- Pajamas
- Socks & Underwear
- Jacket/sweatshirt
- Tennis Shoes (Required for vaulting & other activities)
- Cowboy/Hiking Type Boots or Sturdy Sneakers (*Required for riding & animal care; should provide a good amount of protection. Sturdy sneakers are fine in place of boots. No slip-on or flimsy sneakers; must be lace-up with good, thick material.*)
- Hat (Cowboy and/or baseball-style)
- Bandana (great for wearing while riding)
- Shower shoes/flip flops
- Bath Towel/Washcloth (Rawhide does NOT provide towels)
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, brush, toothbrush, toothpaste, *deodorant, lip balm, etc.*) Small bag for carrying to/from showers
- Sunscreen, Bug Spray, Personal Hand Sanitizer
- Re-fillable water bottle
- Warm Sleeping Bag, Pillow, Extra Blanket for cold nights (cabins have bunk beds with foam mattresses)
- Ear Plugs (in case there's a noisy sleeper in your cabin)
- Camera (*Leave those expensive digital cameras at home, please!*)
- Flashlight & batteries
- Small Fan for cabin & Batteries during warm seasons (clip-on, battery operated fans are great for clipping onto bunks)
- Rain gear (just in case - during rainy season)
- Spending money (\$20-\$30 cash only, small bills only please)
- Bag for Dirty Laundry
- Extra garbage bag to re-pack sleeping bag on last day

## What to Leave at Home:

- EXPENSIVE CAMERAS & VIDEO EQUIPMENT
- All electronic equipment/games
- Cell phones (adults ok)/Tablets/I-Pods/CD players/radios
- Personal Sports equipment
- Pocket knives/hazardous materials
- Illegal substances

Due to fire marshal and insurance regulations, portable heaters/electric heat sources of ANY kind are not allowed in the sleeping areas.

**Cabins ARE NOT Heated or Cooled**, so please pack accordingly!  
Check our local weather forecast prior to coming (Bonsall, CA 92003).

Food & beverages (other than water) are not allowed in the cabin areas.

**Rawhide Ranch is an alcohol-free facility!**

## Liability Release Form Requirements:

**EACH PERSON** attending Rawhide Ranch, *regardless of age or participation*, MUST have a completed and signed Liability Release Form on file with the Ranch (parent/guardian must sign for minors).

## How to get to Rawhide Ranch:

### **From Los Angeles/Orange County:**

Drive INTERSTATE 5 South toward Oceanside.

Head EAST on HWY 76.

Turn RIGHT on CAMINO DEL REY, cross over bridge, stay LEFT at the Y in the road.

Turn LEFT onto WEST LILAC ROAD.

Rawhide Ranch is approx. 3 miles up the road; you'll see our sign on the RIGHT.

### **From San Diego:**

Drive INTERSTATE 15 NORTH.

Exit OLD HWY 395, turn LEFT at end of ramp. Go to top of hill; turn LEFT onto WEST LILAC ROAD. Ranch is approx. 1.6 miles up the road; you'll see our sign on the LEFT.

Rawhide Ranch is approx. 1.6 miles up the road; you'll see our sign on the LEFT.

### **From Riverside/San Bernardino:**

Drive INTERSTATE 15 SOUTH, past Temecula.

Head WEST on HWY 76 towards PALA/OCEANSIDE.

Turn LEFT onto OLD HWY 395.

Go up to top of hill. Turn RIGHT onto WEST LILAC ROAD. Ranch is approx. 1.6 miles up the road; you'll see our sign on the LEFT.
