- ★ Hat (Cowboy or baseball style)
- ★ Bandana(s)
- ★ Toiletries (Soap, shampoo, comb/brush, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- ★ Bath towel, washcloth
- ★ Bathing Suit (Girls – No bikinis please; Tankinis OK)
- ★ Pool Towel
- ★ Sunscreen
- ★ Sleeping Bag/Pillow
- ★ Favorite stuffed animal
- ★ Disposable camera – be sure to put name on it (Leave those expensive digital cameras at home, please)
- ★ Flashlight
- ★ **Refillable water bottle**
- ★ Spending Money (\$20-\$30) Cash only – No Pony Bucks!
- ★ Bag for dirty clothes
- ★ Extra garbage bag to re-pack sleeping bag on last day
- PUT NAME ON BAGS – The bags all look alike**
- ★ Bug Spray - Optional
